Fundraising Report – Mary Parker. Encouraged by the Bonfire Campaign results. Interested in pursuing other items such as dog shirts.

Health Director/ Health blog – Geri Wojeck. Geri works a lot of health questions for individuals. She would like to update the breed history with new publications. Would like to consider simplifying the breed standard by eliminating the height requirement. Since it can only be changed every 5 years, we are eligible next year. Other possible terms for Smooth-face would be Midi-coat, Demi-coat, semi-coat, etc. Would like to explain the various DNA tests (i.e., Embark vs UC Davis, etc.) Discuss the shedding gene, the new blue, and the Frenchie chocolate. intensity gene affects red. F2 gene. Diversity study. We'll look for her draft to the UKC for admitting the smooth-face Mi-Ki.
